

REACH compliance statement

The European Union's REACH Directive (EC 1907/2006) is designed to regulate the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical Substances. REACH legislation was finalized in December 2006 and has been in effect since June 2007.

As an importer and distributor of products categorised as articles within the REACH regulations, we review our products with our suppliers and can confirm that our products are compliant and do not require registration.

Under the REACH Regulation Article 33, we are obliged to inform you when a delivered product exceeds a substance of the SVHC candidate list for the authorization process (<https://echa.europa.eu/en/candidate-list-table>) to more than 0,1%. Reference quantity is the smallest component of a compound product.

All of our brass & steel components contain more than 0.1% lead.

Since lead is bound as an alloying element and therefore no exposure is expected, no additional information on safe use is necessary.

Moreover, labelling on the product is not necessary – this means, there is no need to label that it contains an SVHC-substance.

All products distributed by Greenway Electronic Products Ltd fall under the category of Articles within the REACH Regulation and none of them present the notion of intentional release of Substances, therefore no obligation of registration applies.
